

Procedure for Settlement of Disputes

36. (a) Any person who claims to have a grievance against the Association is entitled to request a special meeting with the Management Committee to present his case. The Management Committee shall endeavour to redress the grievance.
- (b) In the event of no settlement being arrived at, the Management Committee and the aggrieved person, shall present their case, either jointly or separately, to the Registrar, Mutual Benefit Organisations, or to a person or persons appointed by the Registrar, for arbitration.

Dissolution

37. (a) This Association may be dissolved by the consent of three-fourths of the members of the Association testified by their signatures to an instrument of dissolution.
- (b) In the event of the Association having insufficient funds to meet claims, this Association may be dissolved with the consent of the Registrar.
