Objectives and Eligibility Criteria

1.0 Objectives

- 1.1 To support students in need by covering essential school-related expenses such as supplies, transport, and meals, thereby reducing financial strain on their families.
- 1.2 To encourage beneficiaries to give back by actively contributing to the Clan Association in the future.

2.0 Eligibility Criteria

- 2.1 Applicants must be children of male members bearing the surname "Sze-to" or "Seet" who are studying in Singapore at the Universities, Polytechnics, Junior Colleges, Primary and Secondary Schools, including Government-funded Special Education Schools.
- 2.2 Applicant's father must have at least 3 years of active membership and no outstanding fees.
- 2.3a For households with income, the: Gross monthly per capita (person) income must not exceed S\$1,500^[1].
- 2.3b For households with no income, the Annual Value (AV) of the home must not exceed S\$21,000^[2].
- 2.4 Students must have passed all subjects in the previous academic year, with an overall average score of at least 60%.
- 2.5 Students must have attained a minimum conduct rating of "Good."
- 2.6 Priority will be given to applicants who have actively participated in and contributed to Association activities.

[1] Gross monthly household income includes basic employment income, trade/self-employed income, overtime pay, allowances, cash awards, commissions, and bonuses.

The household monthly income per person is calculated by dividing the total gross household monthly income by the total number of family members living together.

[2] Households without income please enter the Annual Value (AV) of your property, which can be obtained by logging into mytax.iras.gov.sg IRAS website using your Singpass account
